



Educational Psychology Services with HSR Psychology


We are available to work in an ongoing and an ad hoc capacity depending on your school's requirements for psychology input.

This consultation will be to discuss the specifics of your request and come up with a plan of action for EP intervention such as planning for school visits; consider how much EP intervention is required; face-to-face vs. remote requirements; and the overall goals of our involvement with your setting.
